



Criteria for evaluating:

Paper Presentation / Flash Talk

Relevance to conference theme

The study or the initiative are in-line with the rationale and goals

The references are up-to-date, relevant and high quality literature

Methodology is explained well and fits the goals / The description of the initiative is clear

Key findings or outputs are noted / Evidence for the contribution of the initiative is satisfactory

Discussion is congruent with the findings / Discussion is congruent with the evidence

The proposal offers a novel practical or theoretical approach

The proposal is likely to stimulate a lively discussion concerning significant issues in education

The proposal is written clearly

Criteria for evaluating:

Full session / Reversed full session

Relevance to conference theme

The proposal offers a novel practical or theoretical approach

The proposal is likely to stimulate a lively discussion concerning significant issues in education

The different presentations are relevant to the joint subject and contribute to it

The different presentations are described clearly

The references are up-to-date, relevant and high quality literature

The methodology in the different presentations fits the goals

The presenters in the session come from different institutes in Israel and/or abroad, or come from various fields, or a collaborative initiatives (with preference for collaboration with the community)
